

Trumansburg - Ulysses Youth Commission
Resolution in Support of Land Donation
Passed Unanimously, April 2025

WHEREAS the Trumansburg - Ulysses Youth Commission (the Youth Commission) consists of representatives from the Village, Town, School, and broader community, and operates with technical administrative support provided by the Tompkins County Youth Services Department,

WHEREAS the role of the Youth Commission is to advise the development of community recreation programming and positive youth development existing within the Village, Town, and the Trumansburg Central School District,

WHEREAS in that role the Youth Commission has conducted and been made aware of multiple community surveys and needs assessments regarding youth development and the provision of recreational opportunities, all of which indicate a real and substantial need for an increase in public spaces within the Town of Ulysses to meet the needs of the community,

AND NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Trumansburg - Ulysses Youth Commission encourages the Ulysses Town Board to accept the generous donation from the Pritts Family of 15.234 acres of land on Cold Springs Road in Trumansburg, NY.
