## INTRODUCTION

The applicant and property owner, Spencer Schaffer and Melissa Littlefield, applied for a minor subdivision for the subject site to subdivide the existing 48.91 acre lot into two lots, northern lot would be approximately 28 acres and southern lot would be approximately 20.7 acres. The A/R zone requires a minimum lot area of 2 acres, 200 feet of lot depth, and 400 feet of lot width at the front lot line per the Code of the Town of Ulysses (CTU) 212-29.

## **PROCESS**

During this sketch plat review, the Board should review the proposal in respect to applicable state and local laws and regulations pertaining to subdivisions Consolidated Laws of New York (CLNY) 62.16.276 and 277, and CTU 212-140 and 142 respectively), provide comments and general recommendations as to any adjustment needed to satisfy the objectives of the regulations, and schedule a public hearing for the proposal. The proposal is considered an Unlisted action under SEQR for which the Board will act as Lead Agency.
