

RESOLUTION # _____ OF 2026: SCHEDULING A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION OF SMITH WOODS AS A CRITICAL ENVIRONMENTAL AREA

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Ulysses is considering the designation of Smith Woods as a Critical Environmental Area pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act and its implementing regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that Smith Woods may possess one or more characteristics warranting designation as a Critical Environmental Area, including exceptional or unique natural setting, ecological sensitivity, and recreational and educational value, as outlined in a memorandum from the Town Planner dated [insert date]; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to hold a public hearing with respect to the proposed designation of Smith Woods as a Critical Environmental Area.
