Site Improvements

1191 Taughannock Boulevard

Dear Niels,

I am working with Maureen Foley and Jason Brenner on an application to replace a set of wooden stairs at their lakefront cottage at 1191 Taughannock Boulevard. The stairs rise 40' from the west side of the cottage to an upper parking area which sits atop a cliff. The cliff has seen shale erosion over the years, and the stairs need replacement. In order to get small construction machinery to the rear of the cottage, shaving off of a portion of the shale bank between 1191 and 1195 Taughannock Boulevard will be required. Most construction equipment and materials will need to be brought in by barge so the front lawn and landscaped area between 1191 and 1195 will be disturbed. These areas will be restored to their original condition and grade once the work at the rear of the cottage is complete. All loose shale material, rock, and old retaining walls will be removed to clear the way for the new stairs.

Stormwater and Erosion Controls

This project will not create new impervious surfaces, so a stormwater plan has not been provided. Silt logs will be installed around the catch basin in the upper parking lot and along the seawall as shown on the drawings to prevent sediments from entering the lake.

Floodplains

The 100-year base flood elevation is 385.6 per the most recent FEMA flood mapping and is shown on the site plans. All work west of the cottage is above the 100-year flood elevation. The east lawn/landscaped area and a portion of the north lawn/landscaped area fall below the 100-year flood elevation and will be disturbed during construction for access to the rear of the cottage. These areas will be restored to original condition and grade thus resulting in no fill being placed in the floodplain. A Floodplain Development Permit will be filed for review by all appropriate reviewing agencies.

Wetlands

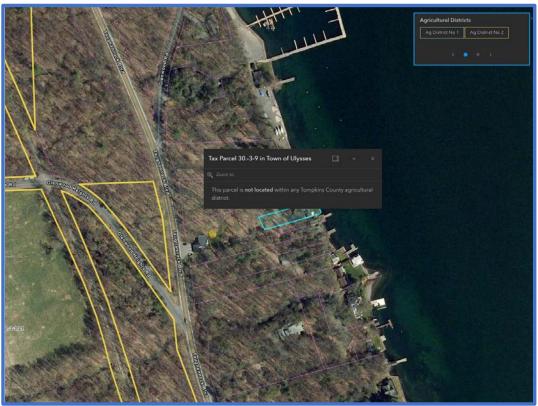
There are no mapped wetlands on the site, but Cayuga Lake is listed as a Federal Wetland. No work is proposed within Cayuga Lake or below the Mean High Water Mark. Requests for letters of No Permit Required or No Jurisdiction have been filed with State and Federal agencies.



Agricultural Data Statement

Certain lands in the Town of Ulysses lie in an area that has been designated as an Agricultural District. Section 283-a of the New York State Town Law requires any application for a Special Permit, Site Plan, Use Variance or Subdivision on property within such a District containing a farm operation or on property with boundaries within five hundred (500) feet of a farm operation located in such a District to include an Agricultural Data Statement.

1191 Taughannock Boulevard does not contain a farm operation but is within 500' of Tax Parcel 32.-2-3.25 which is in Tompkins County Agricultural District 2. Tax Parcel 32.-2-3.25 does not contain a farm operation, so an Agricultural Data Statement is not required. See images below.

Tax Parcel 32.-2-3.25 is in Ag District 2 but Not Farmed



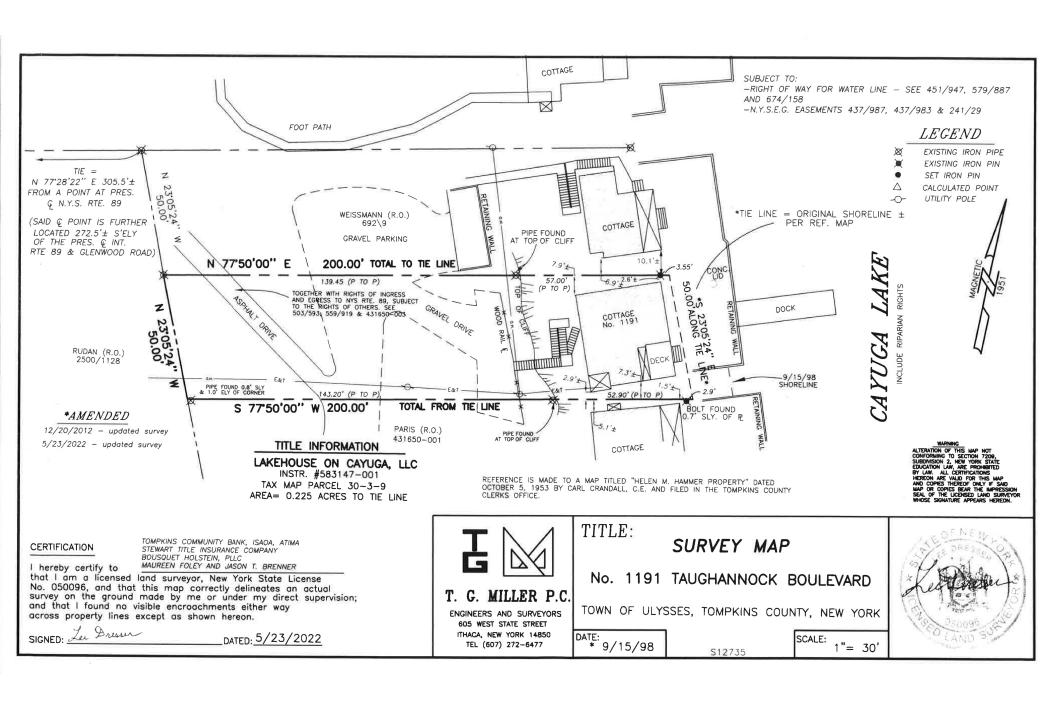


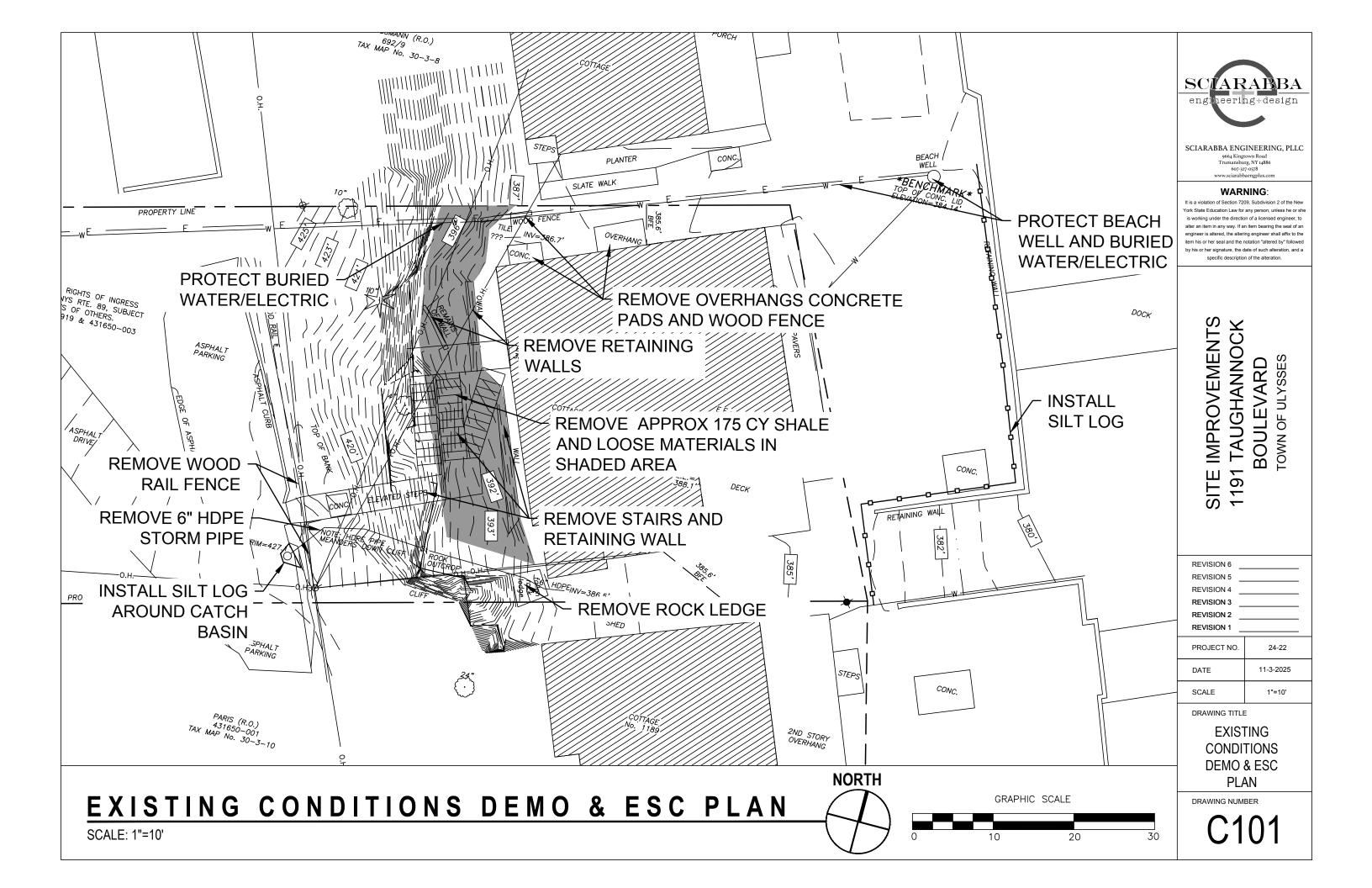

EXISTING VS PROPOSED STAIR FOOTPRINTS

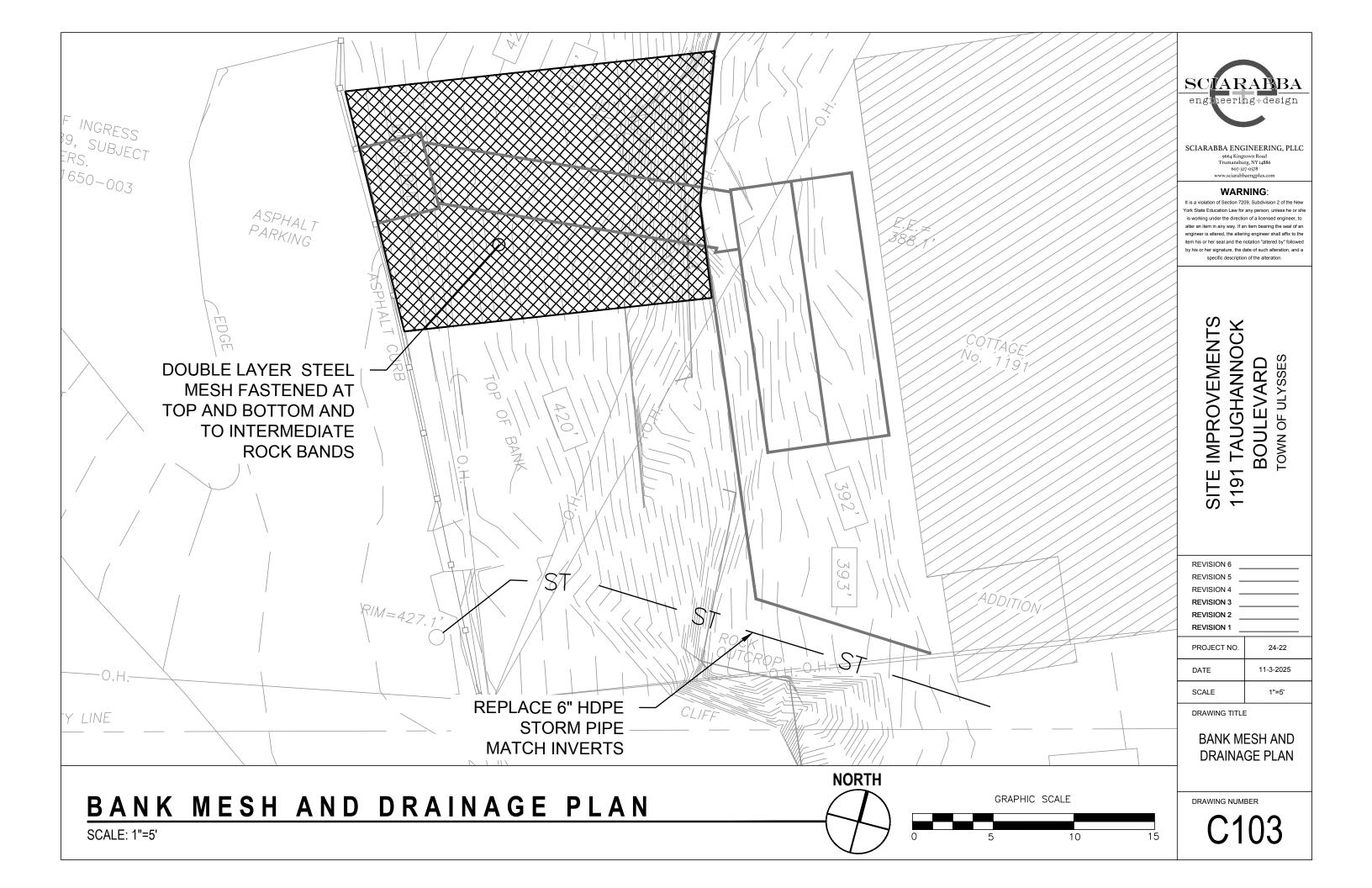
